Keep in mind when making reservations, Families, Couples & single female members and guests will be assigned to rooms. Single males will be assigned to End of Hall or Cold Shoulder. Please be flexible.

When making reservations please give me 24 hours to respond to your request. I can take care of your reservations when the following information is in your email much quicker. Please ALWAYS have your ARRIVAL DATE and DEPARTURE DATE in that initial request. Please ALWAYS list FIRST and LAST names of ALL Guests. Please tell me if your guests are a couple and or if they live in the same household. Once again if a guest is 20 years of age or younger, please list their age next to their name. This is pretty much common sense, but I have to send an email back to almost every reservation I get when guests are involved.

With Covid-19 cleaning and disinfecting the area's you use at the LODGE is CRITICAL. Be sure to WASH & DRY the sheet that is on the bed that you use before you leave. Please leave the sheet folded on the bed so the person that uses that room and bed know it's clean. A recommendation if you don't have time to wash and dry the sheet...is bring a flat sheet from home to use that would work on any bed you might be assigned to.

Winter KEYS are DUE BACK TO ME. Please drop them off at my house or mail them to my home address. Those keys were due back to me on May 1. Since we have not had any meetings it's been difficult to get those keys back to me. Send me an email to let me know if you are mailing or dropping off your Winter Key.

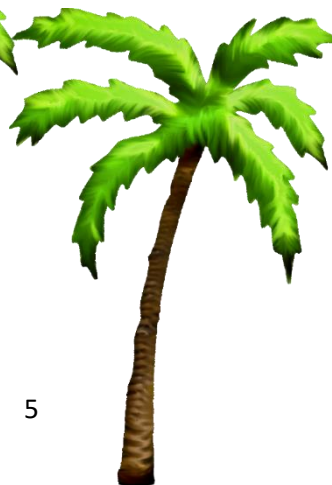
Hello Members !
