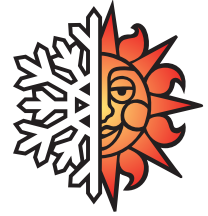

### Greeting's!

Summer is almost here and there is still some snow to ski on. There are a few members trying to get some skiing in this last weekend of May. Some members have scheduled group reservations, see list below of those dates. Midweek reservations are easy, it's the weekends that are filling up. Its great to see the Lodge being used so much during the summer!

**Winter Key Holders...your keys are due back to me!** Plan to return your Winter Key by mail or drop off at my home. If you decide to keep the key through the summer the additional amount is \$95.00.

FYI...mark your calendars for the FALL Work Weekend. Dates are September 23-25, 2022. Please email if you are planning on attending this Work Weekend. Lodge painting project. Here is the proposed schedule to have some repairs and the Lodge painted during June. June 8 & 9 the Lodge will be being pressure washed. June 10 Lodge will have windows and doors taped. June 11 is the day painting is going to start and this should take 3 days. This is a tentative schedule and subject to change. To be safe make reservations before June 8 and after June 14. Tim Hutton is planning on staying at the Lodge, so we have a member present while all the construction and painting workers are at the Lodge.

This is a reminder list of protocol that should be followed while at the Lodge. Be sure to turn off lights! I get emails just about weekly that when a member has arrived the found lights on when they arrived, and no one was at the Lodge. Please close all drapes and blinds before leaving for home plus LOCK ALL Windows and Doors. This is another issue I get emails about...members find the windows are not locked and blinds are left open. Be sure to clean all areas you use while at the Lodge. Do not leave perishable food in the refrigerators or on counter/table. If you leave any condiments in the refrigerators, please date them so the next person knows how old they are.

CLUB EVENT at the Lodge in August 19-21, 2022. Group Reservation Dates: August 3-8, 2022/ September 11-17, 2022. With Group reservations the Lodge is not available for regular reservations the dates listed.

This month is dedicated to Jesse Wagoner. He was Clifford Wagoner's older brother, a past president and long-time member. Jesse's many contributions to our club were invaluable. In a sense he was part architect, part engineer, part stone mason, part iron worker and world's strongest man.

Every time you go to the lodge, you see his handiwork--our fabulous fire place. We are fortunate to have his architectural plans

for the fireplace, the insert and the door.

The plans were drawn up in 1974 and Jesse installed the fireplace. In 1984 he remodeled the fireplace, had plans drawn up for the insert and installed in 1985.

In the summer of 1985 he built the wood door in the rock wall of the fireplace. By Tim's estimate, the door weighs about 1,000 pounds. He comes up with this number because the lodge committee had some repair work done. By the way, all the rocks came from the Truckee area.

Sadly, we lost Jess to cancer years ago.
